



## **ELLOREE PORK FEST 2010 RULES & REGULATIONS**

**April 9 & 10, 2010  
Joe Miller Park, Elloree, SC**

Thank you for your interest in Pork Fest 2010. We are excited about this year's competition and some new additions to Pork Fest. Pork Fest is an event for the competitors and community to enjoy, but is also to help the community. For the past few years, proceeds from Pork Fest have gone to put Christmas decorations up on Highway 6 in Elloree. That project was completed in 2008, and proceeds from the 2009 event funded decorations on Cleveland Street. This year's proceeds will fund local beautification projects at the parks and downtown.

As the name indicates, Pork Fest is a BBQ competition, with a fun twist for Friday night if you would like to participate. Listed below are the rules and regulations. Additional rules and regulations may be found on the application and additional information that may be sent out by the committee.

BBQ for the contest may be prepared using wood, gas, or charcoal cookers, and the teams may prepare and cook in a fashion so long as it is suitable to serve to the public. **WE WILL BE USING BOSTON BUTTS THIS YEAR INSTEAD OF WHOLE HOGS.** No outside meat may be brought or prepared. All entrants must use the meat that is supplied by the Committee, and the teams must prepare all BBQ on site.

All teams are requested to respect the rights of others. No loud music, profane language, alcohol and infringement on adjoining sites. Each team will receive a space for a tent no larger than 10'X20'. Each contestant must meet DHEC standards for food preparation and serving.

The competition is meat only. No hash is to be prepared. No other side items are to be prepared for the competition. We encourage you to provide small samples for at least 200 people to taste.

Saturday's competition has two award categories:

Public Popular vote.

Judged competition that will be sanctioned by the South Carolina Barbeque Association.

Judging will be between 10:30 -11:15. Serving to the public will be 11:00 until 12:30pm or when the pork runs out. Judging will be conducted by a professional panel of judges that will base judging on flavor and taste. An overall winner trophy will be awarded in each category along with the following cash prizes for judge-determined winners:

1 <sup>st</sup> Place:	\$200.00
2 <sup>nd</sup> Place:	\$150.00
3 <sup>rd</sup> Place:	\$100.00
4 <sup>th</sup> Place:	\$75.00
5 <sup>th</sup> Place:	\$50.00

On Friday night you may voluntarily enter one other competition. **ANYTHING BUT PORK.** The rules are simple; you may make anything but pork. The event will start at 6:00 pm and serving of your dish will continue until 7:30 or until samples run out. You must meet all DHEC standards for food preparation and serving. The public will have an opportunity to vote for your anything but pork dish, and a panel of judges will also judge for an overall winner. A \$100.00 cash prize will be awarded to the winner selected by the judges.
