



## ELLOREE PORK FEST 2012 RULES & REGULATIONS

April 13 & 14, 2012

Thank you for your interest in Pork Fest 2012. We are excited about this year's competition and some new additions to Pork Fest. This year Pork Fest has been revamped to include more local participants, an event for the entire community to enjoy and benefit from. We are no longer members of the South Carolina Barbeque Association. Entry fees are \$50 per team, payable in advance to the Town of Elloree.

As the name indicates, Pork Fest is a BBQ competition, with a fun twist for Friday. Listed below are the rules and regulations. Additional rules and regulations may be found on the application and from additional information that may be sent out by the committee.

BBQ for the contest may be prepared using wood, gas, or charcoal cookers, and the teams may prepare and cook in a fashion so long as it is suitable to serve to the public. **WE WILL BE USING BOSTON BUTTS THIS YEAR INSTEAD OF WHOLE HOGS.** No outside meat may be brought or prepared. All entrants must use the meat that is supplied by the Committee, and the teams must prepare all BBQ on site.

All teams are requested to respect the rights of others. No loud music, profane language, alcohol and infringement on adjoining sites. Each team will receive a space for a tent no larger than 10'X20'. Each contestant must meet DHEC standards for food preparation and serving.

The competition is meat only. No hash is to be prepared. No other side items are to be prepared for the competition. We encourage you to provide small samples for at least 150 people to taste.

Saturday's competition has two award categories:

Public Popular vote.

Judged competition that consists of one judge from each participating team.

Judging will be between 10:30 -11:00. Serving to the public will be 11:00 until 12:30pm or until the pork runs out. Team judging will be based on flavor and taste. First, second and third-place trophies will be awarded in each category.

On Friday night you may voluntarily enter one other competition. ANYTHING BUT BBQ. The rules are simple; you may make anything but barbeque. The event will start at 6:00 pm and serving of your dish will continue until 7:30 or until samples run out. You must meet all DHEC standards for food preparation and serving. The public will have an opportunity to vote for your anything-but-bbq dish, and a panel of judges will also judge for an overall winner. A trophy will be awarded to the winner selected by the judges.
