



# Household Garbage & Yard Trash Guidelines

## Household Garbage

- Garbage service is available to in-town residents only, and billed on your water/sewer bill at **\$9.00 each month per can.**
- Elloree household garbage is picked up on **Thursday mornings.**
- Garbage pick-up may be delayed 1—2 days if there is a holiday during the week.
- Cans should be placed out by the street in front of your residence no later than 5:30am Thursday morning or Wednesday evening.
- All cans should be removed from the road as soon as possible.
- Garbage must be placed inside the can. No loose items or store purchased cans will be picked up.
- Yard trash must not be placed in household garbage.  
(See **Yard Trash**)
- Broken or damaged cans should be reported to the Elloree Town Hall.



# Yard Containers

Large containers are available to In-Town residences for larger yard clean-up projects.

## No household trash or construction debris.

- Containers may be requested on a first come basic and kept for 24 hours.
- Contact the Elloree Town Hall at 803-897-2821 to have a container delivered to your residence.
- Large limbs should be placed securely inside the container for transporting.





# Yard Trash

Yard Trash includes:

- Grass clippings
- Leaves
- Small Limbs

\*All Grass clippings and leaves must be bagged during the months of October thru January.

\*Limbs must be no larger than 4 feet long and 4 inches in diameter.

\*Yard Trash is picked up on Mondays and Thursday mornings each week. (Pick up may be delayed by holidays)

\*Yard Trash including, but not limited to, trees, grass clippings and limbs generated by commercial landscapers must be removed by the landscaper.
